

Isaiah 53:1-8; Luke 22:19

INTRODUCTION

Today we gather as believers to share communion. We will proclaim that we are holding the broken body and shed blood in our hands. The question for us today is, "How does God's brokenness fix us?" When I speak of God being broken, I speak of Christ, the suffering servant, on the cross.

- I. Servant
 - A. The suffering servant is Christ.
 - B. The call of the servant is to be a servant.
- II. Sin
 - A. Separated from God
 - B. Our sin, bruised, wounded, and put stripes on the Servant.
- III. Salvation
 - A. Grace God offers it to us.
 - B. Our brokenness is fixed by the Servant's pain.
