God of Expectations Luke 5:17-26

INTRODUCTION

Verse 20 of our text said Jesus “saw their faith?” Can Jesus see our faith? You might ask, what does faith look like? The men who saw the need of the paralyzed man and believed Jesus could change his circumstance, brought him before Jesus. They came expecting God to work. How have we come today? What are we expecting?

- I. Believe
 - A. Belief is a great motivator.
 - B. These men believed there was hope for a man in trouble in Jesus Christ.
 - C. Do we believe and expect God to work in our lives?
- II. Bring
 - A. Compassion for a man who could not move.
 - B. Compassion will take someone to where they cannot go by themselves!
 - C. Are we willing to bring a friend who is spiritually paralyzed by sin to Christ? What would we expect God to do?
- III. Before Jesus
 - A. This is where belief and the action of bringing result in healing. They came expecting God to work because they had heard about Jesus.
 - B. Today, do we believe that when we bring ourselves or others before Jesus, God will work?

CONCLUSION

Is God, the God of our expectations? Do we expect God to take our **belief** when we **bring** ourselves or others **before** Jesus to make a difference?
