

### **Matthew 2:1-12; Numbers 24:7**

Introduction: On this second Sunday in Advent, we have lit the candle of peace on earth. The prince of peace will come to Bethlehem in a most turbulent time to lead all who will follow his light to the peace that passes understanding. This morning, lets come into the light that leads us to God's peace.

#### I. A light that is **SIGNIFICANT**

- a. The wisemen were students of the stars
- b. Something significant usually shows up where we study.

#### II. A light that is **SEEN**

- a. We have seen his star and have come to worship him.
- b. When you see the light of Christ, you can never "unsee" it!

### III. A light that is SOUGHT

- a. When you SEE something SIGNIFICANT, you follow!
- b. What are we seeking this Christmas?

Conclusion: Is the light of Christ leading our life this morning? It is if it is significant to us. It is if we have truly seen the light of God. It is if we are seeking him in all we do.
