



## A Light that Remains Matthew 5:14-16

Introduction: During this advent season, we have looked at the light of Christmas. We have reminded ourselves of the light that was coming, the light that leads and the wonderous light that is the glory of God. Today, on this last Sunday of Advent, next Sunday being Christmas day, let us look at the light that remains, the church that is made up of disciples - people who are doing our best to act, sound, speak, and live like Jesus.

- I. Reflects
  - a. Jesus gives an imperative: "You are ... "
  - b. The light that remains points others to the light of the world.
- II. Radiates
  - a. Not Hidden or covered.
  - b. The light that remains must find a place of on the lampstand and become one of the many lights on that make up the city on the hill!
- III. Redirects
  - a. People see our good works and are redirected to look past us!
  - b. The light that remains redirects them to the Heavenly Father.

Conclusion: Today, you and I are told by God that we are the light that remains visible on this earth to point the world to the glory of God. That is our purpose. We must live a life that remains faithful to reflect, radiate, and redirect the lost to the glory of God.
