Matthew 4:18-22 (ESV)

Introduction: Receiving a call this day in time is much different than it was many years ago. Now with caller ID, Spam alert, and the ability to cut off your ringer, many potential calls never happen. In the world in which you and I live, we might ask, "does God still call people?" Yes, God still calls, today lets make sure we answer that call.

- God's call is SIMPLE
 - a. In the call of the first four disciples, Matthew tells us it was one sentence.
 - b. God's call is simple: "Follow me"!
- II. God's call is SPECIFIC
 - Jesus used a idea that these men could completely understand.
 - b. Fishermen understand fishing, Jesus called them to change their catch!
- III. God's call is STOP
 - a. In verse 20 and 22, we find the word "immediately."
 - b. God's call is to do it now!

Conclusion: Are we ready to answer God's call for us? It is a daily call that requires our daily response. I am so grateful for God's call upon my life. How about you?
